Pursuant to RSA 485-A:17 II-b.(a): Within 50 days of receipt of the application, the department shall request any additional information required to complete its evaluation of the application, together with any written technical comments the department deems necessary. Any request for additional information shall specify that the applicant submit such information as soon as practicable and shall notify the applicant that if all of the requested information is not received within 120 days of the request, the department shall deny the application. The department shall grant an extension of this 120-day time period upon the request of the applicant.


This mutual agreement clarifies and supersedes the agreement signed by the department and the applicant's authorized agent on 12/21/23.

Pursuant to RSA 485-A:17 II-b.(b): If the department requests additional information pursuant to subparagraph (a), the department shall, within 30 days of the department's receipt of the information:

- (1) Approve the application in whole or in part and issue a permit; or
- (2) Deny the application and issue written findings in support of the denial; or
- (3) Extend the time for rendering a decision on the application for good cause and with the written agreement of the applicant.
